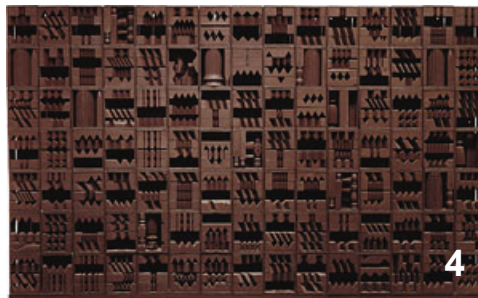
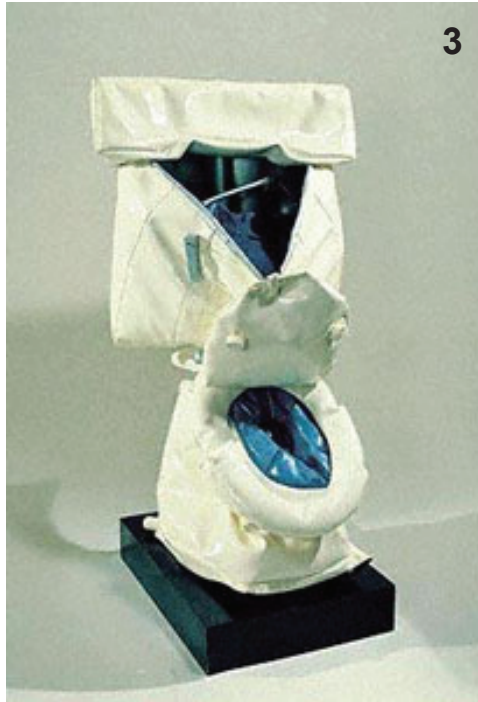
FINE ARTS 102, Pottery and Sculpture 1, TEST 2

BISQUE FIRE: first firing at a low temperature where the clay still maintains a porous state

GLAZE: coating of glass that is fused to the surface of a ceramic piece

GREEN WARE: unfired pottery or sculpture

KILN: a structure built to fire clay at high temperatures
